In the eastern docklands of Amsterdam, a former paint factory has been quietly transformed into a creative hub. Originally built in 1958 and now designated as a municipal monument, the building sits within the redeveloped Cruquius district, a part of the city where industrial heritage meets contemporary reinvention. Today, it houses the interior architecture studio of Heinzl De Vries, alongside a barista supplies brand and other creative enterprises.
